The bus transfers will be carried out by the bus operators themselves. The TID e.V. will collect the travel costs for the bus trips and the invoices will then be sent in mid-May. The bus transfer can only be organized if the participants agree to pass on their address to the bus operator. The trips can only be organized if there is sufficient participation and they are intended for TID participants primarily.

Bus seats will be reserved in the chronological order of registrations. The deadline for registrations is 30.04.2026, for the bus return from Brăila 28.02.2026.

Since last year we offer to start in or return to Coswig/Anhalt for the trips to/from Vidin, with a stopover at Leipzig. A return trip from Brăila is possible if booked sufficiently.

Departure times at the different starting points are fixed.

In the event of another flare-up of the Corona pandemic, the bus trips could again be subject to requirements such as mandatory face masks.

In general it is not possible to bring dogs.

Boat transport: The boat trailers of the busses can transport about 20 rigid boats. Additionally there is capacity for about 10 folding boats. Particularly long boats (over 5.50 m) must be specified at the time of registration. Canadians or other extra-wide boats can be transported only upon request. No liability will be accepted for damage to boats during transport. See also conditions of participation point 5. Canoe insurance is strongly recommended. Please allow one hour before departure for boat loading!

We would like to point out that the bus trips to/from Vidin or Brăila are very long and exhausting. If necessary, thrombosis stockings are recommended.

Seats for the return bus from Brăila /Romania

The limited number of bus seats for the return journey from the Black Sea/Tulcea (for this year Brăila) and great interest in the Romanian route were a problem on the last trips, because they were often already booked on the first day of the registration phase.

TID is a long-distance journey and should remain so. In order to give a chance to participants who want to ride the entire TID and those who have not yet ridden the Romanian section, registrations for the Brăila bus will be evaluated on a points system, not on a first-come, first-served basis.

"Through drivers" or participants who travel a longer route receive one bonus point for every 1000 km to the Romanian border. Anyone who has not used buses on the Romanian route in the last 5 years (in which this was possible) receives half a bonus point per year .

The evaluation of the points will be available in March and those registered will be informed from mid-March to what extent they have a bus seat or where they are on the waiting list. Experience has shown that there are always some cancellations up to the start and on the long route.

We ask you to refrain from making interim inquiries!

Since the number of interested parties is available as a side effect of this extended registration phase, it can also be determined whether a second bus is worthwhile. Our experience with this registration system means we have better planning options and no "registration stress".

Start- and finish points:

In Winzer this is the local parking lot in 94577 Winzer, Passauer Straße. Directions: Motorway A 3 - exit Hengersberg (111) or Iggersbach (112). From Hengersberg drive in the direction of Winzer. In Passauer Straße at the end of the village there is a large parking lot on the right, next to the sports field. Coming from Iggersbach drive in the direction of Winzer. At the beginning of the village in Passauer Straße there is this parking lot on the left.



On Saturday (20.06.2026) before the tour starts in Ingolstadt, the cars can be brought to Winzer or Erlau in the morning. The bus ride from these places will be organized in Ingolstadt. The bus costs will be passed on to the users.

Departure and arrival points in Austria are the Ybbs service area on the A 1 freeway between Passau and Vienna and the Schwechat service area on the S 1 Vienna bypass. There are no other stops. The loading of the boats on the return trip abroad will take place the evening before or one hour (!) before departure. Please bring your own straps.

Start in Coswig/ Anhalt at Wricke Touristik GmbH 06869 Coswig, Ziekoer Landstraße 2 A. Cars can be parked on the premises of Wricke Touristik. An overnight stay in Coswig/ Anhalt is possible at the canoe club Coswig: <https://www.kanuverein-coswig.de/bootshaus/>.

Stopover at the A9, exit Leipzig/West IKEA parking lot.



Overnight accommodation in Winzer:

The start to Mohács is in the morning at 7:00. An overnight stay in Winzer is probably possible, as in recent years in the nearby clubhouse of the sports club (on your own air mattress). Alternatively, there are (also for the return trips) the following guesthouses:
